

# Dallas

County Dallas English. Dallas County located in the U.S. state of Texas. Officially formed in 1846 from sections of the counties of Nacogdoches and Robertson and named in honor of George Mifflin Dallas the 11th Vice President of the United States. As of 2000 the population was 2 218 899. According to the Bureau of census of the U.S. population in 2008, the number of County residents increased to 2 412 827 people which corresponds to the ninth place in the list of the most populous districts of Texas. The district centre and the largest city is the city of Dallas the third largest city in the state and ninth in the United States. Dallas is a city located on the Trinity river in the North-East of the state of Texas and the administrative center of the eponymous district. It is the third largest city in the state 9th in the United States of America. The population of the town exceeds 12 million inhabitants and its area covers almost 1,000 square kilometers. The climate can be described as humid subtropical. Dallas is one of the hottest cities in the world, second only to Kuwait. In General the city is located in the plains. Through its Central part flows the Trinity river on both sides of that towering 15-meter high embankments prevent flooding. Now a few large companies have been implementing the project of construction of a large bridge over the river and the coastal part of downtown Dallas plan to turn into a large green area. Another popular water attraction in Dallas is lake white Rock. Near the lake is a large beautiful Park where you can meet a lot of rowers cyclists, skateboarders and simply rest of people. In addition, on the shore of the lake is the Dallas arboretum and Botanical garden which covers more than 27 square kilometers. In the second half of the XIX century to the West of Dallas, a small group of artists and musicians from Europe, he founded a utopian commune called La Renuion. After the demise of the commune many of its inhabitants moved to Dallas where, eventually, they formed a kind of art district to the existing area Deep Ellum that near the center. In 1873, the Dallas crossed a major railway routes, thereby ensuring the city's rapid economic development as a major commercial center. Soon the city became one of the main centers of trade in cotton, grain, and bison. Gradually in the early twentieth century Dallas from the agricultural city has become a place where their offices are positioned large commercial banks, insurance companies and financial institutions. In the 30-ies of the last century near the town was discovered the oil field after which he became
